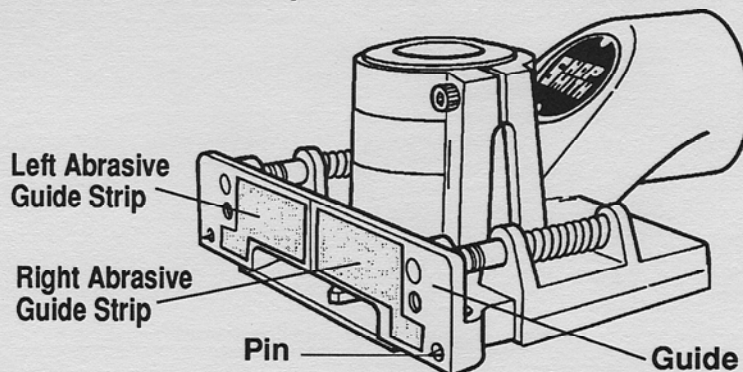




Abrasive Guide Strips

Shopsmith Biscuit Joiner

Introduction

Abrasive Guide Strips help prevent a workpiece from slipping from the guide on the Shopsmith Biscuit Joiner or Universal Biscuit Joiner. This is especially important when one or both pins protruding from the guide into the workpiece, do not penetrate and hold the wood while making cuts in end grain.

WARNING

Do not cut yourself on the sharp, protruding pins located in the face of the Biscuit Joiner guide. Also, operate the Biscuit Joiner using the pins and an end grain fence (if appropriate) whenever possible. Refer to your Biscuit Joiner Owner's Manual.

To install the Abrasive Guide Strips, follow these instructions:

1. Make sure the Biscuit Joiner is detached from the Mark V (or other power source).
2. Set the Biscuit Joiner on a flat, clean work surface.
3. Clean the face of the guide with denatured alcohol and a clean cloth.
4. Peel off the backing from the right Abrasive Guide Strip and carefully attach it to the face of the guide. Align the inside edge of the Abrasive Guide Strip with the guide's center line and the top edge with the top of the guide. See Fig. 1. Do not cover the center line. Starting with the edge nearest the guide's center line, press the Abrasive Guide Strip on the face of the guide.
5. Repeat Step 4 for the left Abrasive Guide Strip.

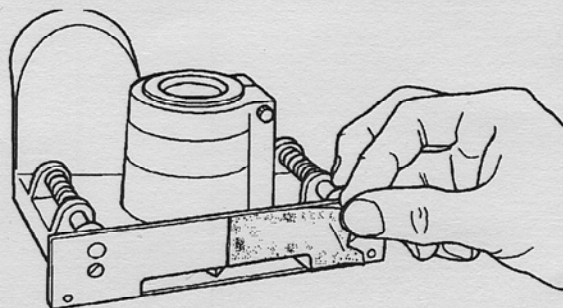
