

INTRODUCTION

The Fence Stop system mounts in the t-slot of the rip fence, allowing you to position a stop for repeat cuts anywhere along the rip fence. The fence stop makes setting up and cutting or drilling in a repetitive motion. This stop system can be used when sawing, drilling, and routing.

The Fence Stop is a flip-stop design, which means that when the stop is not required the stop can be flipped up and the position is not lost.



ASSEMBLY NOTES


Assemble the Fence Stop

1. Using a 5/32" Allen wrench, assembly the screw (7), washer (1), and stop lever (4 or 5, depending on your unit) to the stop block (3).

NOTE

When tightening down the stop lever, after securing backoff the screw 1/16 of a revolution, just enough to allow the stop lever to swing.

2. Assemble the T-bolt assy. (9) up through the stop block (3), secure using the knob (2) and washer (6). See complete assembly, as shown in Figure 1.
